The future of over 400 children (all suffering from Polio/neuromuscular diseases and coming from extremely poor backgrounds) is very precarious.

There is an acute shortage of funds to buy their food.

- Rajasthan has not recovered from a severe drought
- Allowances granted to these children which in itself is very meagre are not readily forthcoming

- Inflation has hit the food prices – even essential items have gone up as much as 50% within 1 year

If these children are sent back to their homes there is **no chance** of any education whatsoever and thus **no future**. Many could have their lives reduced to begging.
