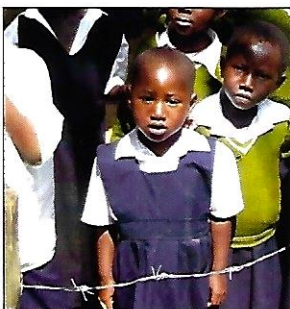

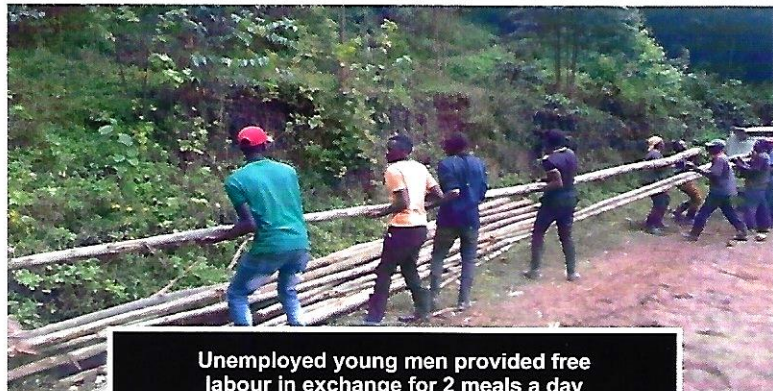

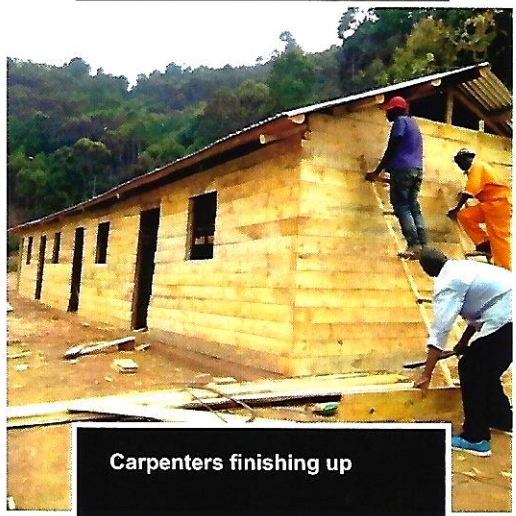

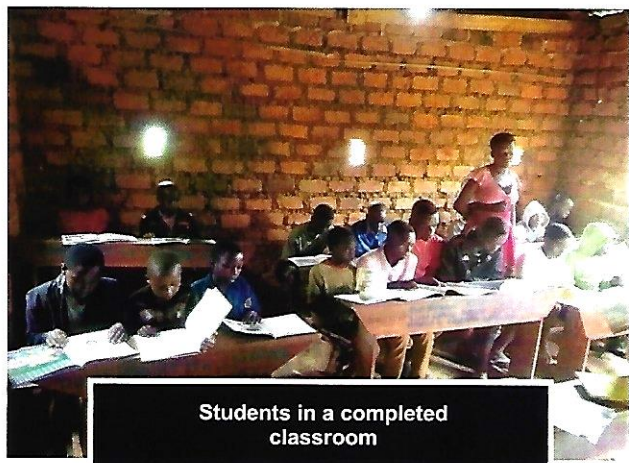

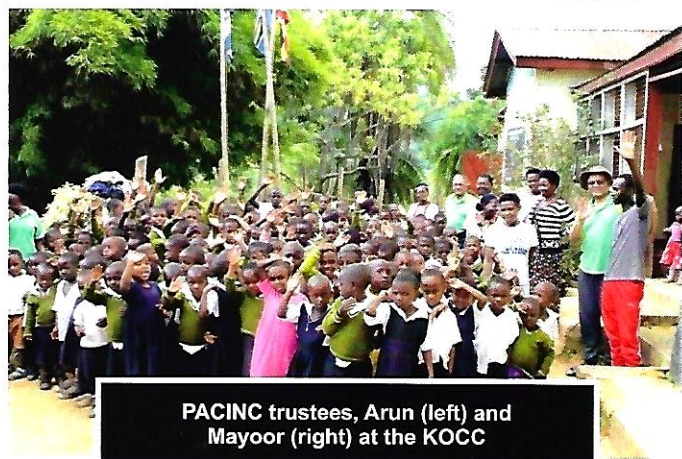

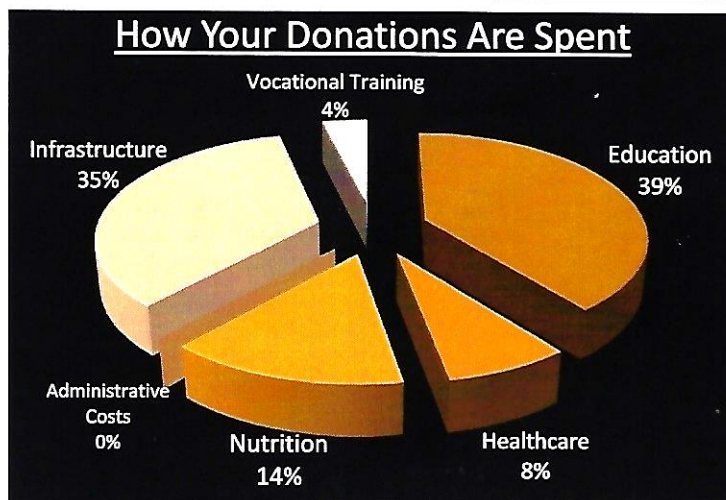

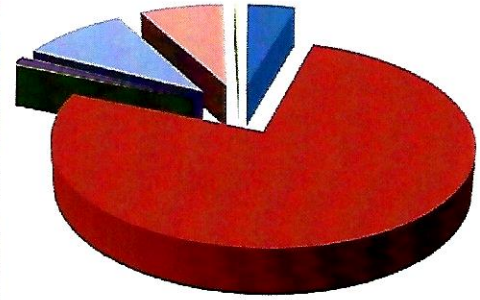

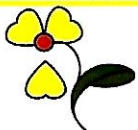

In the Indian state of Telangana, more than 2000 children are born with deafness every year. Our partner, Shravana, has screened more than 135,000 children. The new equipment will increase their screening capacity manifold. Children identified as having deafness are fitted with hearing aids (inset) and provided with Auditory-Verbal Therapy (above)



PACINC supported the purchase of a 4X 4 vehicle for the benefit of 60 disabled children at Kwa Mkono, Tanzania. The vehicle is a "life saver" particularly during the heavy tropical rains when the site is otherwise completely cut off from the rest of the world.

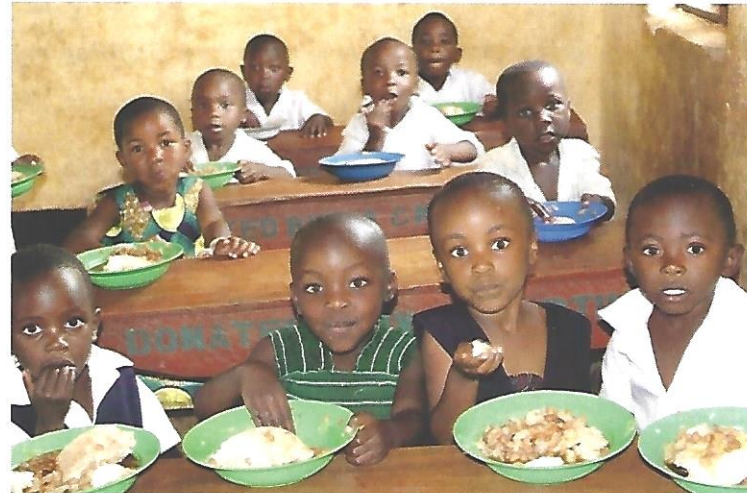
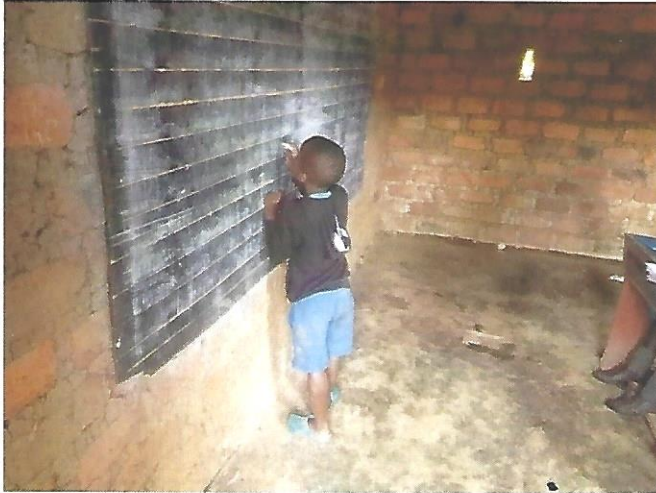

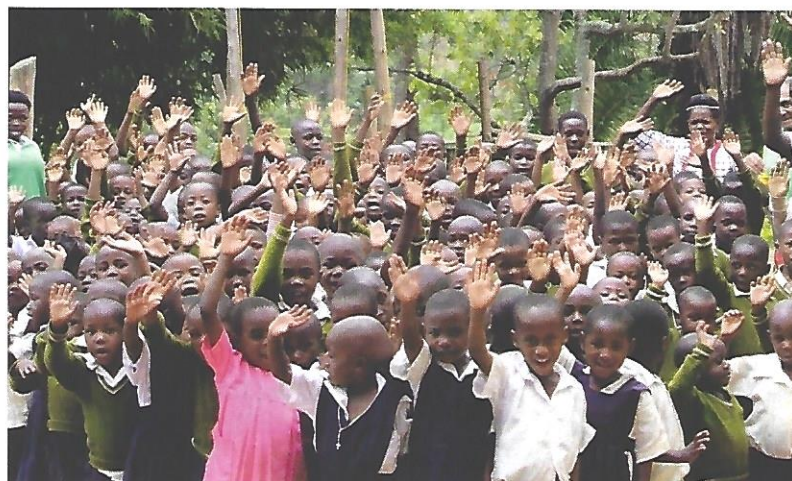
